'Did You Know' Fact?


What is Oceanography?

Environmental News

'Item 1

On World Ocean Day at the UN Oceans Conference in Nice, France, the UK government finally announced its plan to ban **destructive bottom trawling in parts of 41 UK Marine Protected Areas (MPAs)!** While this is not a total ban, it is a great victory for some of the UK's most precious underwater ecosystems, beloved marine life and small-scale fishing communities.' says Greenpeace. [An Angel Shark was sighted for the first time in UK waters in July. These creatures need destructive bottom trawling to be stopped.]

David Attenborough's new film 'Oceans' is now available on National Geographic. In interviews leading up to the release of the film, David said 'we all need to realise that the oceans are more important than the land.'

Item 3 - some Good News quickies:

- A new study from Germany found that a large agrivoltaic solar farm has become a major breeding site for skylarks.
- China just built the world's first grid-scale sodium-ion battery storage.


- New Marine Protected Areas (MPAs) have been announced around the world including French Polynesia (1.1 million km² - Pacific) and Tanzania (1.3 million km² - Indian Ocean)
- Tonga has declared they will become the first jurisdiction in history to grant full personhood to whales. They will appoint legal guardians to represent cetacean interest in Tongan courts (similar to current norms for human children). WOW!
- Reports to the UN Oceans Conference also confirmed that whilst Earth's marine ecosystems struggle with record-high heat waves, menacing ocean acidification, plastic pollution and other threats ... conservation is understood to be more important than ever to give wildlife the time and space for a chance to evolve and adapt. Much of the world is now stepping up to meet the challenges. Yes, folks the World really is taking action.
- Item 4 an interesting 'law development'. The International Court of Justice held this week decided that failing to protect the planet from global warming could be a violation of international law. Judges in The Hague stated 'failure of a state to take appropriate action to protect the climate system may consitute an internationally wrongful act. They called the climate crisis an existential problem of planetary proportions that imperils all forms of life and the very health of our planet. The ruling came in a suit bought by the low-lying island state of Vanuatu and was backed by 130 other nations. UN chief Antonio Guterres said 'This is a victory for our planet, for climate justice and for the power of young people to make a difference. Young Pacific islands initiated this call for humanity to the world. And the world must respond.' The information here shows that the USA, and Washington in particular will need to change their ways. The President of the USA needs to stop his present denial of climate change and stop supporting BIG OIL companies like Exxon.
- This new International Law will be useful at the next COP30 meeting of the global climate talks which will be held in Brazil in November.
- Item 5 Chinese data!
- 1. Bejing has ended all imports of oil and gas from America.
- 2. China is currently installing 100 solar panels a second, and
- 3. more than half the cars China sells are electric.
 They are telling BIG OIL to buzz off !! Let's join them.
